### Darelle White Files for Pflugerville City Council, Place 3

Pflugerville, Texas – Darelle White, a 13 year resident of the City of Pflugerville, filed on August 2nd as a candidate for the special election for Pflugerville City Council, Place 3. The special election for this council seat is scheduled to be held on November 7<sup>th</sup>.

Place 3 candidate, Darelle White, has been a resident of Pflugerville since 1993. Darelle, a member of First Baptist Church Pflugerville since 1992, resides in the Meadow Park South subdivision with his wife, Donna, of 31 years, and has two sons. Donna is a teacher in the Pflugerville Independent School District.

Mr. White, is a graduate from Sam Houston State University with a BBA in Marketing and has done post-graduate work at the University of Houston where he received his Masters in Business Administration. Currently, Mr. White serves as Academic Director in the Academic Development Department of The National Alliance for Insurance Education & Research in Austin, TX where he has been employed since 1992. Prior to 1992, Mr. White was responsible for management and underwriting of commercial insurance accounts for Aetna Life and Casualty Company in Texas, Arkansas and Oklahoma for 15 years.

Locally, Mr. White is the current President of Pflugerville Pamilies Pfirst (PPP). While participating in that organization, Darelle actively participated in efforts to block the proposed racetrack and the recent successful campaign to prevent the construction of a strip club bordering Pflugerville's northwestern boundary and was co-coordinator of the highly successful PPP fundraising effort for the Pflugerville Fallen Warrior Memorial Project. Recently, Mr. White was appointed by the Pflugerville City Council as a board member to the Pflugerville Community Development Corporation (PCDC), a 4B sales tax funded organization designed to spur economic development in the city. Further, Mr. White has been an active volunteer coaching youth athletics in baseball with his sons. His activities include serving as a volunteer booster for the Pflugerville High School band and other charitable projects for the city through his church and the school system.

Mr. White brings nearly thirty years of commercial, financial and marketing experience to the City Council at a time of rapid residential and commercial growth in Pflugerville. Acknowledging that the city is at a developmental crossroads, Mr. White sums up his vision for the city noting that one of his main goals for the future is to “focus on economic development that is compatible with the city's neighborhood setting”.
